
WHAT'S ON FEBRUARY 2026




JAMES ARTHUR




SARACENS: SHOWDOWN 6




GARAGE NATION

3 April

THE GRAND NATIONAL

9 -11 April

Aintree Racecourse, Liverpool, UK

MATT RIFE

11, 23 April

SAUDI ARABIA F1 GRAND PRIX

17 - 19 April

Jeddah Corniche Circuit

The Formula 1 Saudi Arabian Grand Prix tears through Jeddah's ultra-fast Corniche street circuit under the lights — knife-edge sweeps, walls inches away, and a breathtaking rush down the seafront. Expect ruthless DRS blasts, bravery into the high-banked Turn 13, and strategy calls made at 300km/h. Night, neon and no margin for error — pure, white-knuckle spectacle.



STAGECOACH FESTIVAL

24 - 26 April

Empire Polo Club, Indio, CA

25 April

COPA DEL REY FINAL


WHAT'S ON MAY 2026

The O2, London, UK



18 May - 8 June

Expect brave lunges into Turn 1, relentless DRS warfare down the main straight, and tyre-deg strategy that flips the order late. Cool night air, hot pace — pure desert drama.
